- [Ramsar Convention](#) on Wetlands of International Importance especially as Waterfowl Habitat, signed in Ramsar, February 2, 1971.
- [European Landscape Convention](#) signed in Florence, 20 October 2000.
- [Agreement on the Conservation of Aquatic Warbler *Acrocephalus paludicola*](#) concluded on 30 April 2003 in Minsk, Belarus, in accordance with Article IV, paragraph 4 of the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals, known as the Bonn Convention.
